OPENER, MIDDLE BREAK & CLOSER:

Four ladies chain across the ring. **Roll away** and then **circle left**. **Four ladies roll away, circle left** around I say, do a **left allemande** the corner, **weave around the ring**.

****If It's hers I'll be long gone tomorrow. Swing your girl and promenade.**

FIGURE ONE:

Head (Side) couples promenade go half way. Down the middle and **square thru four**.

Four hands around and then you do the **right and left thru**. **Veer left** and **ferris wheel** you do.

Centers **square thru** 3/4 round now. **Swing** the corner **promenade**.

There's no way that I can make both of us happy. I don't know if I should break her heart or mine.

FIGURE TWO:

Heads (sides) square thru in the middle and go now. To the corner do a **dosado**.

Swing thru tonight and then the **boys run right**, do a **half tag scoot back** and go.

Do a **single hinge, ladies trade, recycle** and then, **swing** the corner girl and **promenade**.
