OPENER

Circle! When I saw you buyin' Cosmo and a hot rod magazine, I said to myself, "Now there's a girl for me". **Left allemande** your corner, do a **dosado**. **Men star left** and turn it one time and go. You **turn the partner by the right** and **left allemande**; **swing** your girl and **promenade** the land. I said, "How 'bout some music?" You said, "Got any Merle?" That's when I knew you were my kind of girl.

FIGURES (twice for the heads, twice for the sides)

The **heads (sides) square thru** and get four hands around you go. **Dosado** your corner one time you know. **Swing thru** today, those **boys run** I say. **Bend the line go right and left thru** and turn her today. **Flutterwheel** straight across now, **slide thru**; **swing** that corner girl, **promenade** you do. And when we went to dinner you wore blue jeans with your pearls. That's when I knew you were my kind of girl.

MIDDLE BREAK

Sides face **grand square**. You march to the beat of a different drum; the funny thing is that I hear the same one. We both like to color outside of the lines; we're peas in a pod... All **four ladies promenade**, well, get back home and **swing** your man and go. Keep that one – **promenade** 'round you know. And when we went to dinner you wore blue jeans with your pearls. That's when I knew you were my kind of girl.

CLOSER

I said, "I think I love you," you said "What's not to love?" I thought about a kiss but I wasn't quick enough. **Left allemande** your corner, **dosado** your own. The **men star left** and turn it one time and go. **Turn the partner by the right** and **left allemande**; **swing** your lady **promenade** the land. You set my head a-spinnin' just like a tilt-a-whirl. That's when I knew you were my kind of girl.
